**FIRE AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE MEETING**

The District Fire and Emergency Management Committee will meet on Thursday, July 26, 2018, at 10:00 a.m. in the Board Room of the Templeton Community Services District at 206 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Templeton, CA.

**AGENDA:**

- 1) Plan for Voter / Property Owner Approved Tax Measure: The Committee will discuss options to enhance Fire and Emergency Services Revenue via Special Benefit Assessment and/or Parcel Tax, analyze amount of current funding shortfall, and begin development a plan that can be put into place to seek additional (voter approved) revenue following the release of the County Fire Study.
- 2) Communication Strategy: The Committee will discuss the strategic communication options for use during the period of time prior to formally seeking a voter or property owner approved revenue enhancement, including communications about the current challenges that Fire and Emergency Services is facing, and evaluating the option of using a public relations consultant to assist in the effort.
- 3) Study on Fire Services in Unincorporated Areas of the County: Staff will provide an update on the County Fire Study.
- 4) Operations Update: Staff will provide an update on current operations, challenges, etc. including overnight coverage during the challenging summer months and fire season.
