NORMS AND CODE OF ETHICS

The Templeton Community Services District Board of Directors has adopted Operating Principles of the Board consisting of Processing Norms and Code of Ethics. The Board is committed to the practice of these norms and code of ethics to set the standards for communication, process, relationship and capacity norms.

In what appears to be a breach of these norms or code of ethics, we are committed to addressing this perception first to the individual(s) involved, before raising the issue with the Board.

It is in this spirit that at each Board Meeting a norm and/or code of ethics will be reviewed as a reminder of our continued commitment to these standards.

NORM:

- Relationship Norms - Establish, accept and support common purpose and vision, and not undermine the authority of the Board after decisions are made.

ETHICS:

- Ethics 4010.1.6 - Directors should commit themselves to focusing on issues and not personalities. The presentation of the opinions of others should be encouraged. Cliques and voting blocks based on personalities rather than issues should be avoided.
