**Significant Incident(s):**

On 5/7/22 at approximately 16:10 7195 was dispatched to the report of a pink fluid leaking from the ceiling of the Devita Dialysis center. Upon arrival Captain Wall determined they had a possible hazardous material incident. Captain Wall requested Chief Peterson and a Hazardous Material Assessment Team. Upon Arrival Chief Peterson assumed Incident Command and confirmed a possible Haz Mat Incident. The San Luis Obispo County Haz Mat unit and County Environmental Health arrived and they were briefed on the situation. The team member made one entry and determined



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a pink liquid was coming from a broken pipe coupling in the ceiling. After identifying the chemical Chief Peterson consulted with Haz Mat Team members and determined the best plan of action would be to attempt to stop the leak. At this time approximately 200 gallons had already leaked out of what was estimated to be a 1000-gallon system. The team made entry with the assistance of Templeton Fire personnel and stopped the leak. The incident was turned over to County Environmental Health and the person responsible for the property. Templeton Fire and the Haz Mat unit spent approximately 4 hours on the incident.
