• **Sports & Events Updates –**

- **Softball/T-Ball** – Ended May 7 with the End of Season Tournament. Three Templeton teams brought home the gold in their respective divisions (8U, 10U, and 12U). There are two All-Star teams forming now. Templeton is hosting the 18th Annual Hot Summer Daze Tournament on June 10-12.
- **Flag Football** – Registration period complete on May 20.
 - Games to be played on Friday nights at Evers Sports Park.
 - 110 players signed up so far. Expecting numbers to rival season's past.
- **Concerts in the Park** – Wednesdays from June 15-August 24
 - Bands announced.
 - Vendors & Sponsors confirmed. Working toward solution for Beer Garden.
 - Flyer in May water bill.
- **Soccer** – Registration began May 1. Already have 85 players registered as of May 11. Expecting another big season for Templeton's most popular sport.
- **Summer Camps/Clinics:** Staff are working to fill the summer calendar with camps and clinics.
 - **Basketball Open Gym** – Mondays from 7-8pm at Templeton High School Gym beginning April 18.
 - **Basketball Camp** – August 8-12. Both Basketball activities led by THS Coaches Andrew Cherry & Lawren Ramos.
 - **Soccer Camps** – July & August dates have been set for two soccer camps.
 - **Scout Camps at Skate Park** – Working with Kevin Campion to host 2 sessions of Scout Camp in Late June and Early August.

- **In other news:**

- **Evers Park Improvement Plan** – Parks, Recreation, and Refuse Committee met to discuss potential adjustments to the entry of the park as related to ADA requirements. There is an increase to the size of the sidewalk needed, as the original plan did not include the handrails as deemed necessary by SLO County pertaining to ADA. There will be related changes to the design of the entryway, with a potential bid alternate to expand the driveway section in an effort to make up for the space lost by the expanded sidewalk.
- **Prop 68 Per Capita Funds** – We have received the official contract documents to certify our successful application for the Prop 68 Per Capita funds. Staff will begin to request funds from this for appropriate projects shortly.
- **Community Garden** – The Community Garden has re-opened for planting and rented 3 garden plots, in addition to the Giving Garden area. Mid-State Solid Waste has graciously donated fill dirt, compost, and wood chips to assist in beautification efforts.
- **Templeton Community Library Reading Room** – TCLA will likely be moving out of the Recreation Department building this summer as work on their new location is expected to be completed in June. Staff are working on solutions for the loss of rental income, including the addition of community classes.
