

TEMPLETON 4TH OF JULY FIREWORKS SAFETY & RULES

TEMPLETON FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES & TEMPLETON CSD WANT YOU TO KNOW:

Only Safe and Sane Fireworks purchased from a permitted booth in Templeton may be discharged within Templeton CSD Boundaries from 12pm on July 1st through midnight on July 4th, 2020.

Please follow the rules for a safe, sane, and enjoyable 4th of July Celebration!

DO

- * Have a bucket of water or garden hose ready to extinguish flames or fires.
- * Place discharged Fireworks in a bucket of water.
- * Have a responsible adult present at all times. Even sparklers can cause 2nd degree burns!
- * Read and follow directions of each Firework.
- * Turn in illegal Fireworks without penalty to the Fire Station, located at 206 5th St.
- * Check with SLO County Parks before planning a gathering at the County Park in Downtown Templeton.

DO NOT

- * Use any illegal Fireworks such as M80's, Firecrackers, Cherry Bombs, Bottle Rockets, or any Firework that flies through the air or explodes. Possession is a misdemeanor!
- * Modify or alter Fireworks in any way.
- * Point or throw Fireworks at people or pets.
- * Set off Fireworks in banned areas:
 - Templeton School District Property, (including parking lots).
 - Within 100-feet of the Templeton Feed & Grain building.
 - Evers Sports Park and Tom Jermin, Sr. (Bethel) Park. Both parks will close at 6pm.
 - Anywhere there is dry grass.
