COVID-19 RESPONSE INFORMATION AS OF MAY 5, 2020

ESSENTIAL SERVICES

Templeton CSD continues to perform many essential services for our community, including potable water delivery, wastewater collection, fire and emergency response, and more.

Staff remains committed to serving our community. Many are working from home.

Staff Members physically reporting to work sites have amended schedules to minimize direct contact.

PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES

All organized youth sports activities and public events operated by Templeton CSD have been postponed. Detailed contingency plans have been developed for the return of each activity and event.

Evers Sports Park and Tom Jermin, Sr. Park both remain open to the public, but play structures have been closed.

The Skate Park, Recreation Department, Book Room and Community Center/Women's Center are closed to the public through May 30. Please contact the District Office at the end of the month for updates.

All Facility Rentals have been canceled through May 30. Please contact the District Office at the end of the month for updates.

Weed Abatement remains mandatory, beginning May 1, 2020.

Application deadline for permits to operate Fireworks booths was extended to April 30, and is now closed.
