

Fall Chipping Days



Templeton Community Services District, the SLO County Fire Safe Council, and the Templeton Fire Department are offering a Fire Safe/Green Waste Chipping program October 19-23. This program is offered to all within the Templeton Community Service District.

How to take part in Chipping Days:

- Mail in or drop off the registration portion at the bottom of this page by 5pm on Friday, Oct. 16. *(This is a first come, first serve program).*
- Carefully follow the “Important Information” in yellow.
- Make sure you have your piles ready by 8am on Monday, Oct. 19 *(regardless of the day you are scheduled for chipping).*

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: PREPARING FOR THE CHIPPING PROGRAM

- **Material to be chipped must be clean, chippable yard waste only—no metal, nails, barbwire, garbage, rocks, leaves, etc. *Clean piles.***
 - **Not allowed: lumber, grass, grape vines, poison oak, leaves, juniper bushes and other light non-chippable or non-vegetation material.**
 - **Branches cannot be thicker than 6” in diameter.**
 - **Piles need to be neatly stacked to make feeding into the chipper less difficult (ends facing the curb). *Smaller piles are easier to work with.***
 - **Piles cannot be greater than 1 ton (approximately 15 ft. wide x 15 ft. long x 5 ft. high).**
 - **All material must be piled near the curb (road frontage) by 8am on the first morning of the event.**
 - **Prepare to have chips left at your site after chipping.**
