- 9) Field Striping Options: Staff will discuss with the Committee the options for striping of the athletic fields.

Evers 2, softball field, is full of weeds. So much so, that softballs that get hit in the dirt, where the weeds are, bounce up and hit kids in the face or body because of the large weeds. The community would appreciate if the fields were fixed/repared and maintained on a regular basis to support our youth sports to give them a safer place to practice and play games.
