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- 2) Recreation Programs Update: Staff will discuss with the Committee the status of the fall youth soccer program, upcoming youth basketball season, as well as the cancellation of the Jingle All the Way Run for 2021.
- 3) IWMA Update: Staff will discuss with the Committee the latest issues related to IWMA, including increases to fees charged to haulers by IWMA, the County withdrawal, proposed new interim JPA agreement as well as proposed new interim MOA with Special Districts.
- 4) SB 1383 Implementation: Staff will discuss with the Committee the steps the District will need to take to implement SB 1383 (Organics Recycling), including an Ordinance which enables enforcement of the requirements of SB 1383 within Templeton CSD, an Amendment to the Franchise Agreement with Mid-State Solid Waste and Recycling, as well as a Prop 218 Notice and Fee Adjustment for Solid Waste Fees so that Mid-State Solid Waste and Recycling can recoup the increased costs associated.
