



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING OF
TEMPLETON COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
REGARDING INCREASING RATES FOR REFUSE COLLECTION SERVICES**

The Templeton Community Services District will conduct a public hearing on June 21, 2022, beginning at 7:00 p.m. at the Templeton Community Services District Board Room located at 206 5th St, Templeton, California (remote participation via Zoom is also available at <https://us02web.zoom.us/j/83670307361?pwd=S3JmayttcG05SGRGb1JPSUpEYmVqOT09> or by calling 1-669-900-6833 with Meeting ID 836 7030 7361 and Passcode 160668). The hearing will be for the purpose of considering an increase in the refuse collection charges for residential and commercial customers. This will be the only public hearing on the proposed charges.

The District is proposing to increase the refuse collection charges for residential and commercial customers between 3.3% and 12.4%. The typical homeowner with a 32-gallon cart service will see a rate increase of \$4.15 per month. The proposed rate adjustments are being recommended for three reasons: 1) due to tipping fee increases of \$3 per ton since 2019 that Mid-State Solid Waste and Recycling has to pay to the Chicago Grade Landfill for the disposal of solid waste, 2) due to increased charges from 2% (or \$.30 a month for residential customers with services less than \$50 a month) to 5.4% imposed by the San Luis Obispo County Integrated Waste Management Authority related to the implementation of Mandatory Organics Recycling as required by SB 1383, and 3) increased expenses incurred directly by Mid-State Solid Waste and Recycling related to the implementation of Mandatory Organics Recycling as required by SB 1383. Additionally, rates for certain new services such as Commercial Organics Recycling Cart Services and Notices of Violations are proposed. The proposed new refuse collection charges for residential and commercial customers are set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto. If adopted, the new rates will be effective as of July 1, 2022. Additionally, on April 1st of each year from 2023 through 2027, the charges for both commercial and residential customers will be adjusted by the percentage change in the Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County, California Consumer Price Index (CPI) for All Urban Consumers for the twelve-month period ending December of the prior year, as reported by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor. The refuse collection charges, both for commercial and residential customers, have been calculated by allocating the costs of providing refuse collection service among the customers in proportion to their use of the refuse collection service. Such use is based on the number and size of the dumpsters and waste carts used. The refuse collection charge revenue is used solely to pay for the cost of providing refuse collection service within the District.

The property owner shall be responsible and liable for paying the refuse collection charges for the owner's property. At the owner's request, duplicate bills and delinquency notices will be mailed to the service address by the District or its waste hauler.

At the public hearing on June 21, 2022, the District will consider any and all comments and objections to the proposed increase in the refuse collection charges for residential commercial customers and the other matters discussed above.
