Re: Engineering Report for June 2022

Engineering Updates/Activities

- Santa Lucia School Water Service connection/consolidation project: Three quotes for construction of the water service connection were received and a contract was awarded to Kirk Construction in the amount of \$21,671.00. Work on the service connection is anticipated to begin in July with work completed before school begins in the Fall.
- Water Conservation Rebate Program: To date there have been 11 lawn removal rebate applications submitted, 3 of which have been completed.
- Community Facilities District property information updated with County issued and finalized permits for new construction.
- District public works contract prepared for Smith Well Submersible Pump replacement.
- Bennett Way Sanitary Sewer Manhole Replacement Construction administration activities throughout the month.
- Development questions for potential projects as well as will serve letter requests ranging from large residential additions and accessory dwelling units to commercial tenant improvements and larger scale projects continue to come in.
- Ongoing review of several proposed projects within the District including review of utility plans, easements, and conditions to provide service continues.

Nacimiento Water Resource and Recovery Project

- Nacimiento Water Resource and Recovery Project at the Creekside Well Site. Easement appraisal proposals have been requested. A preliminary alignment has been selected and once the appraisal is complete, the easement negotiations may proceed. Next steps will be to prepare a conceptual siting plan for project phasing.

Source Control

- Semi-Annual Certifications for Zero Discharge Permittees were due June 1, 2022. Significant non-compliance is noted.
- Continued efforts to collect representative collection system wastewater samples. New samplers have been selected and included in the upcoming budget.
