Significant Incident(s):

On 7/6/22 at approximately 14:21 E7195 with C7100 responded to an unknown type fire at the given location. On arrival C7100 reported a 20x100 foot spot fire that had spread to about 100' of chain-link fence line. At this time C7100 established Abby IC. E7195 arrived on scene and was assigned to fire attack which consisted of deploying the front bumper line and knocked down the fire. E7195 mopped up the fire of any hot spots and cut line around the perimeter of the fire. The cause of the fire was due to a grinding operation. On 7/2/22 at approximately 21:31 E7195 responded to a vehicle fire on the overpass of N. Main and HWY 101. On arrival C7100 arrived and reported a single vehicle with a fully involved engine compartment. E30 arrived prior to E7195 and began fire attack operations. E7195 arrived on scene and assisted E30 fire attack and knocked the fire down and began the overhaul process. At this time E30 was released. E7195 remained on scene for investigation purposes and to have the vehicle removed.
