• **Sports & Events Updates –**

- **Beer Run** – July 9 at BarrelHouse Brewing Co. Worked with the Templeton Recreation Foundation to host the triumphant return. This event began in 2016, took two years off for Covid, and returned for the 5th run in 2022. There were around 120 runners on the 2-lap course. Numbers are not final for fundraising, which will be split evenly between the Foundation and the Department.
- **Soccer** – Registration began May 1. As of Tuesday, July 12, we had 625 players signed up. Registration lasts through July, with prices increasing after June 30. Expecting another big season for Templeton’s most popular sport.
- **Flag Football** – Games began Friday, June 17. Over 225 kids on 24 teams across 4 divisions are at Evers Park every Friday showcasing their skills and learning new plays. Games run through August 5.
- **Concerts in the Park** – Started Wednesday, June 15 to much fanfare from the community. This week’s scheduled band, Los Gatos Locos, had to back out at the last minute due to extenuating circumstances. We always have a robust alternate list and were able to secure Unfinished with the Beatles for July 13. This is a group that plays Beatles cover songs and is comprised of members from a band who has been a crowd favorite for many years, Unfinished Business.
 - A reminder we do not host a Concert on the second week of the fair, which is July 27 this year.
- **Softball/T-Ball** – Templeton has two All-Star teams, one each in 10U and 12U. Both teams have qualified for California State Games, taking place the weekend of July 15-17.

Both teams have had high quality showings at local tournaments and are excited to see how they fare against the best teams in the State.

- **Summer Camps/Clinics:** Staff have filled the summer calendar with camps and clinics.
 - **Track and Field Camp** – Small numbers but very positive reviews from attendees. Expect to host another session in the future due to this success. Worked with the high school track coach and the Templeton Run Club, along with several high school aged volunteers. Expect to see good representation from Templeton at local all-comers track meets for children in the area.
 - **Basketball Camp** – August 8-12. Led by THS Coaches Andrew Cherry & Lawren Ramos.
 - **Soccer Camps** – July & August dates have been set for two soccer camps.
 - **Scout Camps at Skate Park** – Working with Kevin Campion to host 2 sessions of Scout Camp. Second session coming in early August.

- **In other news:**
 - **Evers Park Improvement Plan** – Working with MIG and SLO County to finalize plans related to changes for ADA access from the street to the entrance.

 - **Community Garden & Skate Park** – Staff are working toward solutions for promoting positive behaviors at the Community Garden and Skate Park. A lot of outreach is being done with the user groups, which tend to overlap significantly. Summer is always a difficult time out there, when the combination of late sunset times and nice weather in the evenings when staff are gone.

 - **Templeton Community Library Reading Room** – TCLA will likely be moving out of the Recreation Department building in August or September as work on their new location is expected to be completed in June or July. Staff are working on solutions for the loss of rental income, including the addition of community classes.

 - **2-Week Preschool Camp** will be held in the building beginning July 19. The preschool will return after Labor Day for their regularly scheduled program.
