Re: ACTIVITY REPORT

• **Sports & Events Updates –**

- **Basketball** – Games began January 7. Inside both high school and middle school gyms again for the first time since March of 2020.
- **Softball/T-Ball** – Registration began December and runs through January. Practices begin mid-February, games begin March 11.
- **Concerts in the Park** – Band applications are being accepted through January 20. Vendor applications and inquiries have begun to come in. Sponsor requests are going out.

• **In other news:**

- **January Storms** – Have had an impact on parks and on our facilities. A small leak in the Recreation building due to a blocked drain on the roof has been remedied. Skate Park drains have been cleared after pooling several feet of water. Parks are closed for organized use by sports teams, specifically the All-Star Soccer program and any other potential facility renters.
- **Evers Park Improvement Plan** – Plans were submitted to SLO County for permits on December 19. There is no information yet on the status or expected approval date.
- **Recreation Center Rentals** – Staff are working with community members to bring in new programs and offerings at the Recreation Department. So far, we have hosted several youth art classes and are looking into the possibility of hosting other after-school activities for the children in Templeton, as well as evening classes for adults.

- **Community Garden** – Has become more of a year-round endeavor with several gardeners beginning winter planting season. We are still collecting annual fees for each plot in March.
