

Water Conservation Requirements

The Templeton Community Services District recognizes water as a valuable and scarce natural resource that needs careful management. By implementing the following mandatory water management requirements, Templeton residents have reduced water usage, allowing us to become 'greener' one water drop at a time.



LANDSCAPE IRRIGATION WATERING SCHEDULES

IRRIGATION OF RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL LANDSCAPES SHALL NOT OCCUR BETWEEN 10 A.M. AND 6 P.M.

NO EXCESSIVE WATER FLOW OR RUNOFF

WATERING OR IRRIGATING OF ANY LANDSCAPE THAT CAUSES EXCESSIVE WATER FLOW ONTO AN ADJOINING SIDEWALK, DRIVEWAY, OR STREET IS PROHIBITED

Ongoing Requirements

NO WASHING DOWN SURFACES

WASHING DOWN HARD OR PAVED SURFACES IS PROHIBITED, UNLESS USING EITHER RECYCLED WATER OR A LOW-VOLUME, HIGH PRESSURE CLEANING MACHINE

LIMITS ON WASHING VEHICLES

USING WATER TO WASH OR CLEAN A VEHICLE IS PROHIBITED, EXCEPT BY USE OF A HAND-HELD BUCKET OR HOSE EQUIPPED WITH A SELF-CLOSING WATER SHUT-OFF NOZZLE
